Through national appeals with organisations such as **BBC** and **The Telegraph**, we have shared real stories from people affected by leukaemia and highlighted the importance of practical, emotional support.

These appeals have helped raise vital funds and ensure more people know where to turn for help when they need it most.

The Telegraph Christmas Appeal (2019)

In **2019**, Leukaemia Care was chosen as one of three charities to be featured in *The Telegraph's* Christmas Charity Appeal. The campaign shared powerful personal stories from people affected by leukaemia and raised awareness of the challenges faced by patients and their families. Thanks to the generosity of *The Telegraph's* readers, the appeal raised **£188,000**, money that has helped fund vital support services including our free information, counselling and helpline.

BBC Radio 4 Appeal (2019)

In **2019**, Leukaemia Care was honoured to be featured on **BBC Radio 4's Radio 4 Appeal**, a long-running weekly programme that invites a guest speaker to highlight a charity and encourage support for its work. On the appeal, our speaker shared personal experiences of how leukaemia affects patients and families, and explained how our services make a real difference in people's lives. The broadcast reached listeners across the UK and helped raise awareness of the need for practical support for people affected by leukaemia, MDS and MPN.
