Wedding favours that give back

Some are now choosing wedding favours that also support a charity. This could be a small item, a token gift, or a simple note to say that a donation has been made instead of traditional favours.

Charity wedding favours are a thoughtful way to share something meaningful with your guests, while helping support people affected by leukaemia.

A meaningful “something blue”

You may also be thinking about the tradition of wearing or carrying something old, something new, something borrowed and something blue.

Something blue is often a small detail, but it can also be something with meaning behind it.

Some couples choose a “something blue” that reflects a cause that is important to them. For example, a small blue item from a charity can be a simple way to include that meaning in your day.

At Leukaemia Care, we offer a blue wax melt that can be used as a subtle and personal “something blue”, while also supporting our work.
